## Scripture Reflection

### He Saw and Believed

Easter Sunday dawns not with trumpet blasts or heavenly choirs, but with quiet footsteps in the dark. Mary Magdalene arrives at the tomb early, while it is still dark (John 20:1). She finds the stone rolled away- and nothing makes sense. She runs to Peter and John, frantic. When John reaches the tomb and steps inside, he sees the burial cloths- and believes.



What did he see? Nothing but emptiness: no angelic appearance, no risen Jesus- just the folded linen. And yet, that was enough to stir faith. *“He saw and believed”* (John 20:8).

Easter faith often begins in the quiet- when light is just starting to rise in the darkness of confusion, grief, or doubt. The Resurrection doesn't erase suffering or explain everything. It invites us to believe even when we don't fully understand. As Peter proclaims in the first reading: *“This man God raised on the third day... everyone who believes in him will receive forgiveness of sins through his name”* (Acts 10:40, 43).

The Resurrection means death does not have the final word. Despair doesn't win. The tomb is empty not because the body was taken, but because death itself has been undone. St. Paul urges us in Colossians to *“seek what is above,”* for we have been raised with Christ (Colossians 3:1). Easter isn't only about something that happened to Jesus- it's about something that has happened to us. We now live a new life, hidden with Christ in God.

St. John Paul II once said, *“Do not abandon yourselves to despair. We are the Easter people and hallelujah is our song.”* The power of the Resurrection means there is always hope- hope in broken relationships, in grief, in addiction, in struggle. Christ has conquered sin and death, and His victory is ours to share.

St. Augustine reminds us: *“We are Easter people, and our song is Alleluia.”* This is not just a seasonal joy; it's our new identity. The Resurrection is not the end of the story- it's the beginning of everything new.

So today, whether you come to the tomb with joy or uncertainty, let Easter meet you where you are. Like John, may you see and believe. And may your life proclaim what your heart has come to know: Christ is risen. Alleluia!

## Reflexión sobre las Escrituras

### Vio y Creyo

El Domingo de Pascua no comienza con trompetas ni coros celestiales, sino con pasos silenciosos en la oscuridad. María Magdalena llega al sepulcro de madrugada, cuando todavía estaba oscuro (Juan 20,1). Encuentra la piedra removida —y nada tiene sentido. Corre a buscar a Pedro y a Juan, angustiada. Cuando Juan llega al sepulcro y entra, ve los lienzos —y cree.



¿Qué vio exactamente? Nada más que vacío: no hubo aparición angelical, ni Jesús resucitado —solo los lienzos cuidadosamente doblados. Y sin embargo, eso fue suficiente para despertar la fe. “Vio y creyó” (Juan 20,8).

La fe pascual suele comenzar en el silencio, cuando apenas empieza a amanecer en medio de la oscuridad del dolor, la confusión o la duda. La Resurrección no borra el sufrimiento ni da todas las respuestas. Nos invita a creer incluso cuando no entendemos del todo. Como proclama Pedro en la primera lectura: “Dios resucitó a este hombre al tercer día... y todos los que creen en él reciben, por medio de su nombre, el perdón de los pecados” (Hechos 10,40.43).

La Resurrección significa que la muerte no tiene la última palabra. La desesperanza no gana. El sepulcro está vacío no porque alguien se llevó el cuerpo, sino porque la muerte misma ha sido vencida. San Pablo nos exhorta en la carta a los Colosenses a “buscar las cosas de arriba”, porque ya hemos resucitado con Cristo (Col 3,1). Pascua no es solo algo que le sucedió a Jesús —es algo que nos ha sucedido a nosotros. Ahora vivimos una vida nueva, escondida con Cristo en Dios.

San Juan Pablo II dijo una vez: “No se entreguen a la desesperación. ¡Nosotros somos el pueblo de la Pascua y aleluya es nuestra canción!” El poder de la Resurrección significa que siempre hay esperanza —esperanza en relaciones rotas, en el duelo, en las adicciones, en las luchas. Cristo ha vencido el pecado y la muerte, y su victoria es también nuestra.

San Agustín nos recuerda: “Somos el pueblo pascual, y nuestra canción es el Aleluya.” Esta no es solo una alegría de temporada; es nuestra nueva identidad. La Resurrección no es el final del relato —es el comienzo de todo lo nuevo.

Así que hoy, ya sea que vengas al sepulcro con gozo o con incertidumbre, deja que la Pascua te encuentre donde estás. Como Juan, que tú también veas y creas. Y que tu vida proclame lo que tu corazón ya ha descubierto:

¡Cristo ha resucitado! ¡Aleluya!
